Annual Education Results Report

The Board recently reviewed the Annual Education Results Report as part of Alberta's Assurance Framework, which aims to build public trust and ensure the education system meets student needs and fosters success. This framework requires school authorities to develop comprehensive education plans that set clear priorities, outline desired outcomes, and establish metrics and strategies for improvement in key areas.

Palliser School Division continues to surpass provincial averages, with positive feedback from both staff and parents. However, one area identified for growth is student sentiment toward learning and engagement at school. Division leadership, school Principals and staff are working closely to identify strategies to address this concern.

This report serves as a public-facing document and represents the Division's commitment to accountability and transparency. It highlights the progress toward achieving goals and promotes continuous improvement. The report is scheduled for approval at the next board meeting, pending the integration of additional information from audited financial statements. Once approved by the Board, it will be publicly available on the Palliser School Division website by November 30, 2024.
